HOW TO PLAY THREE CARD POKER



Three Card Poker Rules

1. Players must hold cards in one hand.
2. Players cannot show their cards to other players.
3. Only English must be spoken during play.
4. The House accepts no responsibility for chips or cash left on the gaming tables.
5. Decisions by the management are final on all the games.

Three Card Poker with 6 Card Bonus offers you three different ways to play your three-card hand. In this game, you'll be dealt three cards, and the dealer will receive three cards, too. Here are the fun ways you can play:

Pair Plus

Place a bet in the PAIR PLUS circle. If your hand contains a pair or better, you win. The better your hand, the more you win! A PAIR PLUS bet doesn't compete against the dealer's cards.

Pair Plus Paytable

Pair	1 to 1
Flush	4 to 1
Straight	5 to 1
Three of a Kind	30 to 1
Straight Flush	40 to 1

Ante/Play

Place a bet in the ANTE circle to play your cards against the dealer's cards. If you like your cards, you must place a bet in the PLAY circle to stay in the game. Your ANTE and PLAY bets must be the same amount.

Ante Bonus Paytable

Straight	1 to 1
Three of a Kind	4 to 1
Straight Flush	5 to 1

Next, the dealer reveals their cards. The dealer must have at least a Queen high to "qualify". If the dealer has less than a Queen, your PLAY bet will push, and your ANTE bet will automatically be paid 1 to 1.

If the dealer has a Queen or higher, the best hand wins!

If your hand is higher than the dealer's you win 1 to 1 on both the ANTE and PLAY bets. But...there's more.

If you have a straight or higher, you'll be paid an ANTE BONUS – even if your hand loses, or the dealer doesn't qualify.

6 Card Bonus

Place a bet in the 6 Card Bonus circle to combine your cards with the dealer's cards. If the best five-card poker hand is a Three of a Kind or better, you win!

6 Card Bonus Paytable

Three of a Kind	5 to 1
Straight	10 to 1
Flush	20 to 1
Full House	25 to 1
Four of a Kind	50 to 1
Straight Flush	200 to 1
Royal Flush	1,000 to 1 (\$50,000 maximum payout)
